There is no cost associated with generating the above-mentioned reports. Some programs may require ongoing service fees and/or transaction based fees.
170.315(h)(1) Direct Messaging	The included direct messaging capability allows providers to exchange or share clinical information to other providers and patients	This certified product may require a one-time cost or ongoing fees should a provider wish to establish a new connection with a third-party HISP. Providers must lodge a service request identifying the third-party party HISP or HIE along with contact information for said connection. E-Health Partners will establish, maintain and support technology to manage the connection.

One-time implementation fee and an ongoing maintenance fee based on usage (usage is determined by the number of applications connected, volume of calls made to the API's and the number of API's used)
